Primary Function:

- Assumes responsibility for providing a quality educational program.
- Formulates appropriate educational goals, instructional strategies, activities, and assessments.
- Reports student growth and programs to parents periodically.
- Maintains discipline within the classroom.
- Participates as a member of multidisciplinary teams; involved with evaluations; educational planning; development of Individualized Educational Plans; program implementation. Provides written reports and documentation. May lead IEP meetings.

Qualifications: To be considered an applicant must possess or have the ability to obtain an Iowa Teacher's Certificate with the deaf/hard of hearing endorsement. It is also strongly preferred to have other endorsements such as the elementary or secondary endorsements.

Applicant must have the ability to reach the level of sign language proficiency designated for the position within the time frame established by the School's Sign Language Communication Policy.

Preferred qualifications:

- Previous experience teaching deaf and hard of hearing students.

Salary and Benefits: Salary will be determined by the successful applicant's educational and teaching experience. (BA degree - \$44,000-\$61,000; MA degree – \$52,000-\$80,000). Comprehensive benefits available.

Work Schedule: These are full-time, school year positions (191 day contract for first year; subsequent years are 189 day contracts).
