The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE), Office of Teaching and Learning (OTL), Division of Learning Services, Kentucky School for the Deaf (KSD) in Danville (Boyle County) has an opening for an Outreach Consultant/Teacher position.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide statewide outreach consultation, assessment services, professional development opportunities and support for children, families, district personnel, and community members for the Western Kentucky Educational Cooperative area.

Provides consultation and technical assistance to district staff, attends Admissions and Release Committee meetings, partners with Vocational Rehabilitation for Personal Future Plans, assists with age appropriate transition planning, assists with district evaluation process, and provides

assessments such as Functional Listening Evaluations. Provides or recommends resources/materials for families and other providers; collaborates with child's other service providers such as audiologist, speech therapist, physical therapist, etc. or assists other consultants in their educational cooperatives.

Organizes and leads Cadre meetings for DHH teachers and providers in the Cooperative area.

Provides professional learning opportunities via summer institutes, parent and professional conferences, school level and educational cooperative presentations.

Organizes, leads, and participates in regional or campus events centered upon an educational theme that is aligned to the Common Core State Standards and/or Expanded Core Curriculum.

Collaborate with adult and same age D/HH role models, subject experts, and community members to provide activities that are age appropriate. Also providing educational sessions for family members.

Serves as a representative at monthly DoSE meetings, cooperatives cadres meetings, Statewide Cooperative Consultant's meeting, DEIC meetings, etc.

Examines recent publications such as those published by Gallaudet University, AG Bell, NTID, HLAA, NAD, and other resources to maintain, increase, and share professional knowledge.

Perform other duties as assigned.
